Butternut Squash *	Excellent storage squash.	105
Honey Nut Squash	Mini butternut shape, with amazingly sweet, bright orange flesh.	110
Delicata Squash	Thin, edible skin with green stripes. Very sweet.	100
Sugar Baby Watermelon	Smaller, red flesh watermelon with seeds.	76
Sarah's Choice Cantaloupe	Sweet, mid-size cantaloupe	76

Greens

Greens, Brassicas and Celery are sold in 4-packs. These are great selections to plant early, as they are all cold-hardy. Late April through May while supplies last.

Salad Mix *	Mix of 10 lettuces. Cut above growing point to get regrowth. Harvest 2-3 times.	28
Broccoli	Heat tolerant variety produces a large head and subsequent side shoots for extended harvest	58
Celery	Grow your own flavorful Midwest celery (not your watery CA celery!). Can be finicky but worth it	80
Cauliflower	Large plant produces large domed head. Bend leaves over the head as it starts to form to "blanch" it	65
Head Lettuce *	A mixed pack of our favorite varieties.	48
Brussels Sprouts	Beautiful long-season crop. Harvest in Fall for best flavor	80
Cabbage Mix	Mixed pack of red and green varieties. Heat tolerant for summer harvest.	70
Rainbow Chard *	Brilliant rainbow stems and large tender leaves. Well-suited to full season harvest	55
Kale Mix *	2 green curly, 2 flat, tender lacinato type. Well-suited to full season harvest.	60

Onions, Leeks, & Shallots

Onions, Leeks and Shallots are sold in 6 packs with 3-4 plants per cell. Late April through May while supplies last.

Yellow Cooking Onions	Great all-purpose fresh and storage onion	100
Red Cooking Onions	All purpose red onion for fresh eating and storage	105
Sweet Heirloom Onions	Excellent heirloom sweet onion with potential to grow quite large.	100
Italian Red Bottle Onions	One of our favorite onions! These elongated bulbs grills beautifully and caramelize well.	90
Shallots	Seed-grown shallot plants that produce beautiful, long-lasting red shallots (variety: Matador)	105
Leeks	Early maturing leeks, can be planted in bunches for baby leeks, or singly for full size fall harvest.	75

Caline: Globe Eggplant	Classic bell-shaped eggplant. (Dark Purple)	65
Orient Express: Japanese eggplant *	Early, long Japanese type. Reliable producer (Dark Purple)	58
Beatrice: Italian Eggplant	Smaller, round lavender eggplants. Dense flesh. (Medium Purple)	62

Flowers

Flowers are sold in 4-packs May-Early June while supplies last

Zinnia Mix *	A mix of Benary and Cactus Flower varieties. Beautiful, showy blooms that are easy to grow!	75
Sunflower Mix	A mix of branching sunflowers that will reach 4-5' tall and continue blooming as stems are cut.	85
Petunias *	Mixed-color blooms on beautiful compact plants, great for borders and containers!	80
Marigolds *	Excellent garden blooms for attracting beneficials, mix of speckled orange and yellow petals are beautiful and edible.	50
Nasturtiums *	Compact plant with delicate edible flowers in a mix of colors, makes a great border.	55
Rudbeckia Mix	Classic black-eyed susan flower in a mix of yellow and autumnal colors.	90

Herbs

All Herbs are sold in 3.5" pots. Late April through late May while supplies last. Basil will be available through early June

Cilantro	Slow bolting variety. Cut and allow for regrowth. Stagger multiple plantings for continued harvest.
Dill	Cut as fresh herb or allow flowers to form for pickling.
French Thyme *	Hardy perennial with short stature. Great container herb!
Greek Oregano	Hardy perennial with moderate growth habit. Overwinters in Wisconsin.
Spearmint	Delicious flavor for summer cooking and cocktails!
Italian Parsley *	Full season growth of large flat leaves.
Curly Parsley	Full season growth of classic frilly leaves.
Culinary Sage	Hardy Perennial, vigorous producer
Chives *	Hardy Perennial, beautiful purple flowers
Rosemary	Not hardy in our region. Grow as an annual, or plant in a pot for overwintering indoors
Sweet Basil *	Classic Genovese pesto variety. We source a wonderful seed variety that is Downy Mildew resistant
Thai Basil	Classic anise flavor, gorgeous purple stems/blooms and dark green leaves.
Opal Basil	Beautiful dark purple leaves. Taste is similar to cinnamon basil.
Lavender	Fragrant and beautiful perennial, butterflies love it!

Tomatillo (green fruit)	Tomatillos, a tangy-sweet tomato relative, are a staple of salsa verde. Plant 2 for best production (green)	60
