	Sweet Basil	Classic Genovese pesto variety. We source a wonderful seed variety that is Downy Mildew resistant	
	Thai Basil	Classic anise flavor, gorgeous purple stems/blooms and dark green leaves.	
	Opal Basil	Beautiful dark purple leaves. Taste is similar to cinnamon basil.
